

MID-SEASON HANDICAP SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

2009-2010

Any bowler wishing to compete in this tournament must contribute \$30.00 or more to the scholarship fund. This can be achieved through the bowl-a-thon, sponsors, or simply donating the money.

One week prior to the tournament the bowlers will be placed in divisions by average high to low. Midseason tournament will have two divisions Division A and Division B bowlers. Tournament center is listed on your weekly schedule.

Handicap for this tournament will be 80% from 210.

This tournament will be conducted in the same manner in each division.

FORMAT:

ROUND 1

The Format for this tournament will be that all bowlers entered will bowl a four game qualifier. Bowlers will move one pair right after each game. (At end of fourth game The top 8 handicap scores will advance to round 2 in each division).

ROUND 2

The top eight advancers will redraw lanes. The bowler who would normally be your partner is your opposition. The high handicap score will advance to the next round.

ROUND 3

The four advancers will redraw lanes. The bowler who would normally be your partner is your opposition. The high handicap score will advance to the next round.

Third place is determined by the high handicap game of the loser from this round and 4th place would be the lowest handicap game from this round.

ROUND 4

The two winning bowlers that remain will bowl a pro-style match on a pair of lanes not being used in round 3.

The top four bowlers remaining will be awarded scholarship points, 5th through 8th places may receive scholarship points depending on amount collected per division and board approval.

The amount of the scholarship point breakdown will be determined by the amount of money collected prior to day of the tournament. All moneys collected will be used to pay the days lineage and the remainder of the money will be issued in the form of scholarships.

The percentage of money for scholarships will be divided by the following formula and Tournament Points will be awarded:

(3) - Qualifiers = 50%-30%-20% split

(4) - Qualifiers = 40%-30%-20%-10% split

(5) - Qualifiers = 30%-25%-20%-15%-10% split

EXAMPLE: Lanes used for each round will be as follows: THREE GAME QUALIFYING ROUND

Round #1	A's	=	11/12 + 13/14 + 15/16	B's	=	17/18 + 19/20 + 21/22
Round #2	A's	=	11/12 + 13/14	B's	=	17/18 + 19/20
Round #3	A's	=	13/14 + 15/16	B's	=	19/20 + 21/22
Round #4	A's	=	11/12	B's	=	17/18
